Increased Community Access – increased access to the river and ruins of Stanton Sugar Mill and Plantation, WW II Ammunition Magazines, Fort St. Leon and other historic sites

Mississippi River Trail - part of a 2552 mile bike pathway beginning at the headwaters of the Mississippi River in Lake Itasca and traveling to the Gulf of Mexico
