

Woodlands To Host Hikes For National Trails Day

The Woodlands Trail and Park will be hosting hikes tomorrow morning in connection with National Trails Day.

Between 9 a.m. and 11 a.m. park officials will be conducting the program "A Bird's Eye View—America's Wetland Birding Trail" offering interpretive hikes through the trail.

Leading tours and hikes will be Richard DeMay, of the Barataria-Terrebonne National Estuary Program and David Muth, of the Orleans Audubon Society.

Those interested in joining the hikes can gather at the entrance to the Woodlands Trail and Park, which is on F. Edward Hebert Boulevard. Organizers said they will use balloons to direct traffic to the park's entrance.

A presentation of progress and future direction of the trails and park will be provided along with refreshments.
